Volunteer Position	
Location	Adoption Fairs are held at PETCO (5020 N. Nevada Ave, Colo. Spgs.) and PetSmart (2160
	Southgate Rd, Colo. Spgs.). Farmer's Market is in Woodland Park.
Purpose of position	To represent TCRAS to the public and serve as an adoption counselor for dogs and/or cats
	in hopes of finding them their forever home.
Description of work involved	For adoption fairs in Colo. Spgs and the Farmer's Market in Woodland Park, you will meet
	at TCRAS to get your supplies and animals and then travel in the TCRAS van to the
	appropriate location. Depending on the number of volunteers attending, personal vehicles
	may need to be taken in addition to the TCRAS van. At the location you will set up a tent
	and/or table and space to represent TCRAS and show the animals you have been assigned.
	TCRAS staff will determine which animals will attend based on adoptability and the
	volunteer(s) animal handling ability. You will spend the bulk of your time representing
	TCRAS and trying to find the animals their forever home by engaging potential adopters,
	sharing about the animal(s), and safely handling the animal(s). It will be to the discretion
	of the adoption counselor and/or Team Lead to determine whether a potential adopter is
	a good choice. The adoption paperwork must be properly completed. At each adoption
	fair at PETCO or PetSmart there will be a Team Lead. The Team Lead has the final
	decision/authority in regard to approving an adoption. The Team Lead also knows how to
	complete the adoption paperwork and is the point or lead person for the adoption fair. At
	the end of the adoption fair or Farmer's Market you will carefully pack up supplies and
	place them in the appropriate bin, load the van, and return everything to the shelter.
Hours volunteers can work	PETCO hours are from 10am-3pm on Saturday and Sunday.
	PetSmart hours are from 9am-4pm on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
	Farmer's Market hours are every other Friday from 7am-2pm.
Level of difficulty	Level 3. Requires standing, lifting of tables, chairs, and tent, bending up and down, and
1=easy	ability to react quickly.
5=physically demanding Skills required	Follow and abide by proper protocols.
